MSH led a multidisciplinary team which was retained by the City of Oshawa to prepare the Oshawa Waterfront Master Plan. The intent of the plan was to create a comprehensive and realistic vision for the extensive and diverse waterfront area.

The plan consisted of a Waterfront Vision Statement", which articulated the City's overarching goals for the area. It also contained a Waterfront Master Plan Scan, which outlined the existing planned roles and functions of each waterfront precinct and summarized how they should be connected.

For each of the six waterfront precincts, an Opportunities Plan was prepared. These plans identified waterfront features, character areas, land and water uses, natural and cultural features, built form and adjacent land uses, key views, transportation and parking, and other relevant issues.

Extensive background analysis was carried out for the Harbour Precinct to address its role as a working harbour with related industrial uses, as well as a hub for recreation activities and potential residential development.
